With the weather being unpredictable, please be sure you are sending your child to the Club and school with the proper attire for the current days weather.

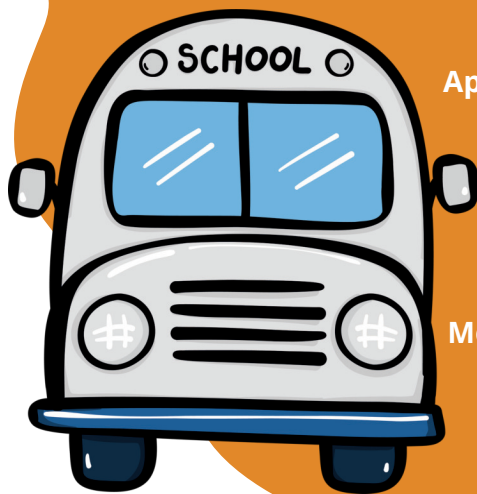
We have some BIG events this month!

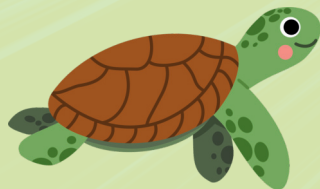

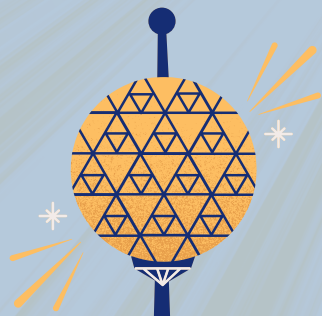
